First Revised Privacy Policy, Revision D as of 02 March 2010

ANNUAL PRIVACY POLICY NOTICE

The Board of Managers of the St. Andrews's Society of Baltimore (SASB) and its affiliate the St. Andrew's Society Foundation Inc., maintain a joint Privacy Policy as required by law, and which is reviewed and as needed revised annually by the Board. A copy of that current Policy is available to all Members on request from the **Secretary** of the Society; or through the Society's Website. That Policy relates to a variety of information, some personal and some potentially confidential as to the submittee, which are provided to or otherwise received or collected by the Society in the conduct of its business and programs.

One example is the publication annually by the SASB of its Membership Directory. Members eligible for inclusion in such annual Directory are advised that if they wish to opt-out of being included in next Directory to be published, or to be included by a name-only reference, they must notify the **Membership Secretary** of the SASB *in writing* at least 60 days prior to cut-off date for publication, as stated in *The Pibroch*. No such elective opt-out will adversely affect a Member-in-good-standing's membership status or rights as a member, nor is there any cost associated to any Member associated with such opt-out. Members are further advised that no such opt-out rights exists or will be recognized with regard to the Society's other publications, including without limitation *The Pibroch* and the SASB's website. Participation, including attendance at any SASB event or function or program, is deemed to be informed and irrevocable consent by the participating Member and that Member's attending or participating guests, to the use of any photographic images, references in any articles, etc., associated with such event or program.

The SASB also maintains a strict Privacy Policy with regard to all information including confidential information it receives in connection with the conduct, applications, deliberations, and management, of its Past Presidents' Scholarship Program, and also with regard to all applications for non-scholarship benevolence grants. A copy of that policy is provided to each applicant and may also be viewed online at the SASB website.
